Internet Rules for Elementary Students
2009 - 2010

1. I will not use the Internet without a teacher's permission and will only go to web sites approved by a teacher or librarian.
2. I will never give out personal information about myself, family, or classmates, such as my address or telephone number.
3. I will tell a teacher immediately if I come across any information that is inappropriate or makes me feel uncomfortable.
4. I will not use any Lexington Public School computer for accessing, sending or checking personal e-mail from any outside account. This includes free sites such as Hotmail, Yahoo, Juno, MySpace, Face Book, Twitter, etc.
5. I will not respond to or send any messages that are threatening, harassing, or otherwise inappropriate.
6. I will not participate in any chat sessions unless part of a class project and supervised by a teacher. I will not agree to meet with someone I "met" online. If a personal meeting is suggested, I will immediately inform my teacher.
7. I will not share passwords with anyone.
8. I will not enter contests or sign up to receive free information or material while using a Lexington Public School computer.
9. I will not download any software from the Internet.
10. I will not attempt to gain unauthorized access to the Lexington Public Schools computers, including access to another person's account or personal files.
